EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

24 HOUR ADVICE IN AN EMERGENCY ONLY: 0800 734 607

IF THIS HAPPENS	DO THIS
Tanker/Vehicle Accident	Switch off engine and electrical equipment. Keep people away, warn other traffic. Check for spills, leaks. Call the emergency services: Dial 111
Spill or leak	Keep all bystanders away. Wear goggles, respirator with an organic vapours and gas filter mask, full length clothing and nitrile rubber gloves. Do not allow to get into surface water, drains and ground water. Absorb spills with inert material and keep in suitable, closed containers for disposal. Seek advice from local authority regarding disposal.
Fire	Call the Fire Service: Dial 111. Wear PVC protective clothing and breathing apparatus. Suitable extinguishing media: water spray, alcohol-resistant foam, dry chemical or carbon dioxide (CO ₂). During a fire toxic fumes may be released. Contain run-off. Keep non-involved persons away.

FIRST AID

If Swallowed:	Rinse mouth. Do NOT induce vomiting. Contact the National Poisons Centre 0800 POISON (0800 764 766) or a doctor immediately.
If in Eyes:	Rinse immediately with plenty of water, also under the eyelids, for at least 15 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Get medical attention if irritation develops and persists.
If on Skin:	Wash off thoroughly with plenty of soap and water, if available with polyethyleneglycol 400, subsequently rinse with water. Get medical attention if irritation develops and persists.
If Inhaled:	Move to fresh air. Keep patient warm and at rest. Call a physician or the National Poisons Centre 0800 POISON (0800 764 766) immediately.

STORAGE AND SEGREGATION SUMMARY

Storage: Store in original container in a cool, dry, well-ventilated place away from direct heat or direct sunlight. Store away from foodstuffs, children and animals. Keep container sealed when not in use.
