DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Mixing:

Half fill the spray tank with water: with agitators running pour in the required quantity of **Teldor**, then top up with water.

Resistance Management:

Resistance to this fungicide could develop in some situations from repeated use. To minimise this risk, use strictly in accordance with label instructions. Do not use more than 2 applications of **Teldor** in the same crop during the same season.

Recommendation:

Crop	Disease	Rate	Remarks
Grapes	Botrytis	75ml/100 litres or a minimum of 750ml/ha	Make two applications at pre bunch closure and veraison, or at veraison and again 14 days later. Apply in sufficient water to achieve good coverage of the bunches.
Boysenberries Strawberries	Botrytis	150ml/100 litres or a minimum of 1.5 l/ha	Make two applications over the flowering period ensuring good coverage of the flowers.
Lemons Oranges Mandarins	Botrytis	100ml/100 litres	Make up to two applications as a full cover spray to point of run-off at full open flowering.

Teldor is compatible with commonly used fungicides and insecticides.

It is an offence for users of this product to cause residues exceeding the relevant MRL in the New Zealand (Maximum Residues Limits of Agricultural Compounds) Food Standards.
